MV Swell is an authentic, coastal tugboat which has been beautifully converted to a passenger vessel with 6 private cabins. At 88 feet in length, her small size allows you to ply deeper into channels and bays throughout the dramatic coastal region of British Columbia. Two zodiacs give even greater access to explore along the shorelines, up rivers, and near wildlife colonies, and they allow you to land on beaches.

Onboard, enjoy the vessels' historical character. The wheelhouse features comfortable seating and excellent views. The wood-paneled salon is a tranquil environment to unwind, while also serving as the dining area. The Main Deck offers panoramic views and a cozy, covered lounge for enjoying the scenery. The Upper Deck has a full 360-degree walk allowing for uninterrupted views of the breathtaking wilderness.

Cabins: *MV Swell* accommodates up to 12 guests in 6 cabins, each one unique in layout and features. All cabins have a private en suite bathroom. Note that to enter and exit your cabin, you will need to be able to step over a six-inch (upper deck) to ten-inch high (main deck) door sill.

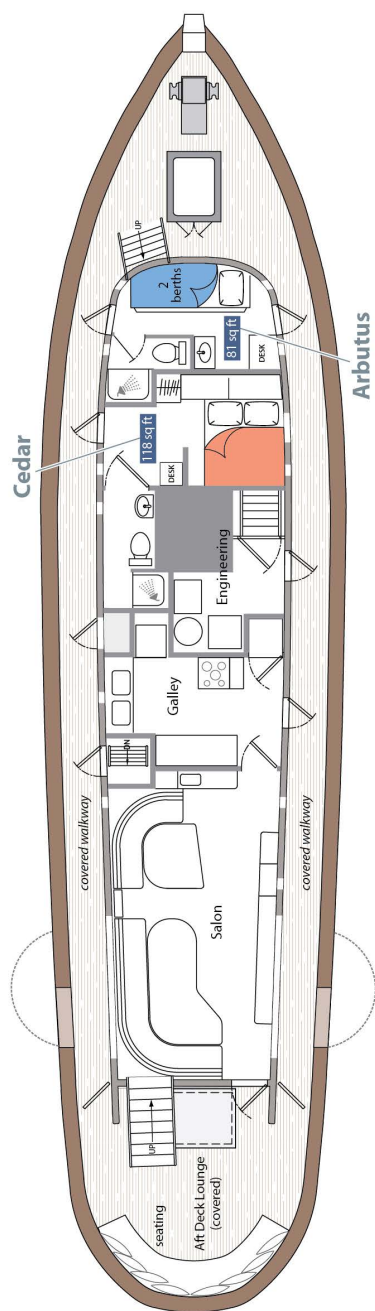
Payments & Terms

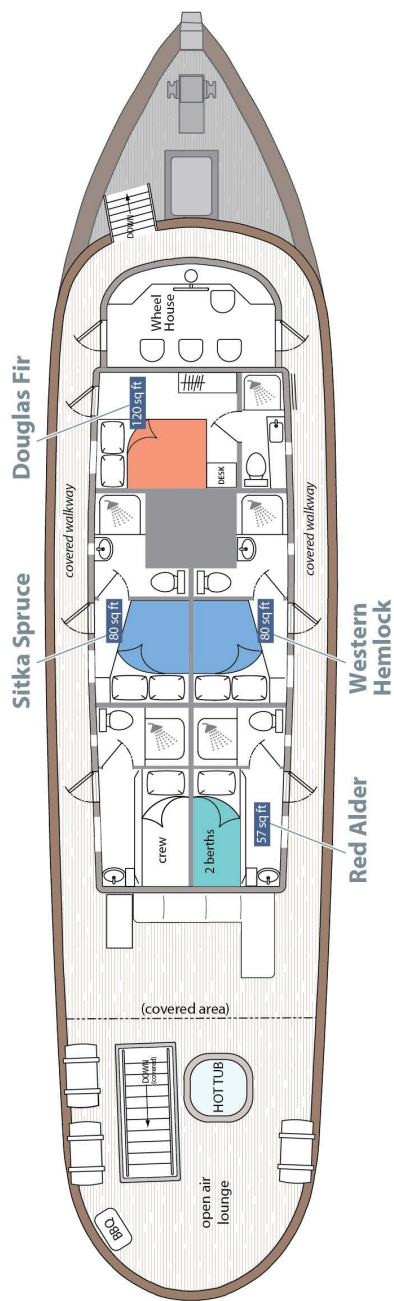


Deck Plan – *MV Swell*

- Douglas Fir



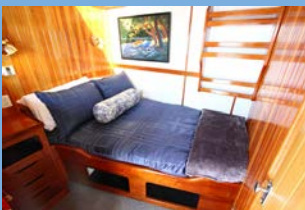
Cabin Details – *MV Swell*

Sitka Spruce



Sitka Spruce is an 80-square-foot cabin located on the top deck. The cabin features a double bed with an angled foot. It has an outside door, opening portholes, private ensuite bathroom, a skylight, and under bed storage.

Western Hemlock



Western Hemlock is an 80-square-foot cabin located on the top deck. The cabin features a double bed with an angled foot. It has an outside door, opening portholes, private ensuite bathroom, a skylight, and under bed storage.

Cedar



Cedar is a 118-square-foot cabin located on the Main Deck. The cabin features an outside door, opening portholes, large private ensuite bathroom, and a small boat queen-sized bed. Cedar has walls on three sides of the bed.

Douglas Fir



Douglas Fir is a 120-square-foot cabin located on the top deck. The cabin features an outside door, opening portholes, large private ensuite bathroom, and a small boat queen-sized bed. Douglas Fir has walls on two sides of the bed.

Red Alder



Red Alder is a 57-square-foot cabin located on the top deck. The cabin features an outside door, opening portholes, and a private ensuite head with a separate washbasin area. The cabin also receives natural light through a skylight. There are two small up and down bunks with, extra-long single beds.

Arbutus



Arbutus is an 81-square-foot cabin located on the Main Deck. The cabin features an outside door, portholes, an ensuite bathroom, and a small desk. There are two large up and down bunks, with the lower bunk larger than the upper.
